Admin Updates:

- Food trucks will continue coming to the consulate until the cafeteria transition is finished. Marines will be cooking on Friday's for the month of May with the exception of the first week due to holiday.
- **CSA Townhall set for May 20th from 6:00 - 8:00 PM** in the Fieldhouse. Free popcorn voucher for attendees.
- **Financials:** The 2024 audit has been reported to CR. Mid year projections put finances around -3,000. Steady in terms of expenses. CSS is increasing enrolling and another forecast after spring camp is complete. Shoppette remains in the negative with the bar the most profitable line.
- **Next Meeting:** Our next meeting will be held on **15 May 2025 from 12:00 - 1:00 PM.**
- **GSO:** Job tickets have transitioned to electronic means. GSO is working on the transition and updates. If community members have any issues with billing please report it to GSO.

Facilities and Infrastructure:

- **Fieldhouse Kitchen:** Currently on time with no delays and facilities is hopeful to open mid- June, but contingent on renovation updates.
- **Shoppette & Quickshop:** CSA is running a cost analysis on products in the Shopette and Quickshop - due to increased in cost of food from purchasers, community members should expect a slight increase in cost.

- Marine Ball planning is in progress. CSA is attempting to secure a venue and sponsors.
