



## CSA Community Update – Meeting July 17, 2025

### Admin Updates:

- CSA is exploring additional revenue streams for community services. Mail delivery service is aiming to have a 1 September start date with a 6-month and 1-year subscription opportunity. More information forthcoming.
- Car wash will likely be coming to the Siedlung in the fall. More information forthcoming.
- Oktoberfest planning is well underway. Looking to incorporate more EFM businesses this year.
- **Financials:** We closed the month of June with an increase in profitability; the Wunderbar and Shoppettee in great standing. CSS camp is helping towards the expenses throughout the year. Hoping to bridge our net loss throughout the year with new revenue streams and increase in CSS enrollment.
- **Next Meeting:** Our next meeting will be held on **21 August at 12:00 - 13:00 in H200.**

### Facilities and Infrastructure:

- **Kitchen Lab:** We have heard positive feedback and the vendor is working to secure set days and menu with occasional theme nights. We are looking at Tuesday - Friday right now, with possibly brunch once a month on the weekend.
- **Quickshop:** Quickshop will soon start the process to be converted to all vending machines with a four week turn around once the go ahead is given. More information forthcoming as we pick a start date.

### Events and Programs:

- **Marine Ball:** A venue has been secured and a contract signed. Planning is ongoing and ticket sales are expected to begin approximately 1 August. More information forthcoming.
