### Admin Updates:

- CSA is exploring additional revenue streams for community services. Discussions are in the works about a car wash service on the Siedlung, souvenir t-shirts, portable keg for happy hours, and mail delivery service from the consulate to the Siedlung.
- CSA is working on finding a better solution for community members to participate remotely in the monthly meetings. Meetings are recorded and we are attempting to put them online for community members to listen at their leisure.
- **Financials:** We closed the month of May with an increase in profitability. We are on track with our YTD net close to 10,000. CSS camp is helping towards the expenses throughout the year. Hoping to bridge our net loss throughout the year with new revenue streams and increase in CSS enrollment.
